Bible Study with Pastor Phil:

Disciple Fast Track: Becoming Disciples Through Bible Study

Studying the Bible is essential to becoming a disciple of Jesus Christ. *Disciple Fast Track* is an adaptation of the original, bestselling *Disciple Bible Study* and is ideal for busy people who want to fit a comprehensive Bible study into their schedule. Classes cover the entire Bible—from Genesis to Revelation—but in a shorter time.

The study lasts for a total of 24 weeks which we will complete in 4 six-week sessions. The first class will be in September and we will make plans for 6 weeks in the spring. In the course, there will be 3-5 chapters of the Bible to read daily.

Our Old Testament sessions will begin Wednesday, September 10 at 10AM and we will follow that with our next Lunch Bunch at noon that day! *We will offer an option for a regular Tuesday evening session that would start on September 9 at 6PM.*
